Front Yard – Both Options:


At this time artichokes fill the raised planter in both options. These get about 4’ tall and will create a nice screen. They also take heat pretty well and are beautiful even if you don’t harvest them.

A variety of native plants will fill the main space.

There are low mounds to help with privacy and plants will further that feel. There is also a small catchment to hold rain and water the nearby plants.

Central Patio :

A central patio allows for planting under the window and softens the entry. It also creates more privacy for the patio and allows the option to have more space. The patio shown in the plan has been made a little larger in the 3D to allow the furniture shown to fit.

Front Yard – Window Patio:

This version shows the patio in front of the window.

Seating and privacy are limited. The area could be softened slightly by adding plants in pots, but the space is still limited and there is not room for a larger pot to create true privacy.

BACK *YARD*



South Garden 1:


Garden is anchored in the south. Planters are set out far enough that they will not be shaded by the wall in winter. Dwarf citrus trees alternate with rosemary to block the heat from the wall, but spaced so as not to allow shade to not sit on the planters all day in the winter. Crossvine grows on the west wall to block the heat from that side.

Zen space and avocado tree are set back in the shady area.

BBQ is built on the patio in a location that allows movement in front of it (wheelbarrows, etc. to get to the garden) and still leaves room behind it.

Play area is on the location of future raised planters.

Other small fruit trees are interspersed in areas with less heat intensity.
